Complaint against the law firm [] LLC, of Limassol.

Regarding the above case and following a session of Section C of the Disciplinary Board, I would like to inform you as follows.

From the complaint, it appears that your allegations against the accused law firm involve the committing of criminal and civil offenses, the adjudication of which does not fall within the jurisdiction of the Disciplinary Board and the Disciplinary Board is not competent to examine the complaint at this stage. If and when such offences are examined by the competent courts and rulings are issued that include findings regarding behavior and/or actions from which violations of the code of conduct arise, then the issue may be re-examined by the Board upon your related request and/or ex officio, provided that they come to the attention of the Disciplinary Board.

Therefore, permission is not granted for the initiation of disciplinary proceedings against the accused law firm.

The fee is forfeited in favor of the Disciplinary Board.
